

Connect 4 Life Privacy Policy

1. Collection of Personal Information

We will only collect personal information that is necessary for the purposes identified and will obtain consent from individuals before collecting their data.

2. Purpose of Collection

Personal information will be collected for specific, explicit, and legitimate purposes, and will not be used for any other purpose without obtaining additional consent.

3. Data Security

Robust security measures will be in place to protect personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction. Data will be stored securely and access will be restricted to authorized personnel.

4. Data Accuracy

We will take reasonable steps to ensure that personal information is accurate, complete, and up-to-date. Individuals have the right to request corrections to their data.

5. Retention Period

6. Consent

11. Children's Privacy

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of 13 without parental consent.

12. Privacy Officer

A designated privacy officer will be responsible for ensuring compliance with this privacy policy and handling privacy-related inquiries and concerns.
